Fremont Insurance Scholarship Qualifications

1. Fremont Insurance will award one \$1,000 scholarship to one student pursuing a career in agriculture or an agriculturally related field.
2. Students must demonstrate a commitment to a career in agriculture.
3. Applications must include an essay describing their decision to pursue an agricultural career. Essays must be limited to no more than 500 words.
4. Applications must include contact information, a current official transcript, and a description of the degree or certificate program being pursued.
5. Graduating high school seniors must provide proof of enrollment in the chosen degree program or some other form of documentation proving a study in agriculture.
6. Applications must be post marked by April 15th, 2026. The winner will be notified by email or phone, and the scholarship will be awarded at Fremont Insurance 933 E Main St. Fremont, MI 49412.

Each Applicant Must Submit:

- Application
- Copy of official transcript
- An essay (max. 500 words) should be written including the following information:
 - Personal background
 - Qualifications
 - Future plans
 - Any other items the student feels would be of interest to the committee
- Two letters of reference from instructors
